### Assam Breakfast £3.50

## Gossainbari Assam (2nd Flush) (organic) £4.20

# Assam Gold £4.80

An exquisite, full-bodied, malty black tea with notes of dark fruit and spice. Assam teas are grown in the fertile soil brought down from the Himalayas by the famous Brahmaputra river. With its large leaf and ample golden tips, this is an example of one of the finest Assam teas, produced on the Attabarie estate. A winner with or without milk, but best take bare to enjoy the subtleties

## Arya Darjeeling (2nd Flush) (organic) £4.20

The famed Indian Darjeeling teas are produced from succulent young leaves with a sprinkling of silvery tips. Known as 'the champagne of teas', the infused leaf brings out a delicate yet robust tasting tea with a smooth base and a subtle honey like, muscatel flavour for which the second flush is celebrated. This one is from the Arya estate which was founded by Buddhist monks over 100 years ago

## Beijing Breakfast £4.50

A sweet, malty tea from the famous Taoist mountain, Laoshan in Shandong. Produced using natural bio-farming methods on a tiny 14-acre estate, Mr Mou's exquisite tea with its caramel oat-like sweetness is unique and hard to come by. Best enjoyed without milk

## Tippy Earl Grey £4.20

A superb quality Ceylon black tea scented with bergamot and decorated with a sprinkling of blue cornflowers to create a rich, full bodied flavour and a striking appearance. Specially blended to complement the addition of milk

## Imperial Earl Grey £4.20

A superior version of the much loved classic Earl Grey. A medium bodied blend of Indian and Ceylon black teas, lifted with gentle hints of sweet citrus from the bergamot. Smooth and subtle, perfect for drinking without milk

#### Flavoured Black Tea

## Indian Chai (organic) £4.20

Assam black tea with the perfect blend of sweet and warming chai spices, for a flavoursome and aromatic treat. In India, chai is drunk following a meal as the spices help promote digestion and cleanse the body. It tastes great with or without milk, and if desired, add a little natural sweetener

## Red Lychee £4.20

This is a classic Chinese black tea recipe, said to have been a favourite of many emperors. Inspired by their love for the lychee fruit, the Chinese use it to scent black tea, capturing its natural sweetness. The result is a caramel smooth black tea with a delightful aroma

## Vanilla Cacao £4.50

A rich, malty blend of Indian Assam and Chinese Yunnan black tea, with Peruvian cocoa nibs and organic Madagascan vanilla. Once used by the Aztecs and Mayans to uplift mood, cocoa and vanilla complement the smooth, deep notes in the black tea base and add a velvety soft finish. A moreish tea with layers of flavour, perfect for a luxurious treat any time of day

#### Green Tea

### Jade Tip Mao Jian £4.20

This is a great tasting Mao Jian (Jade Tip) green tea, grown high in the cool misty mountain air in China. The dark, long, neat twists of green leaf give a brisk, clean, vegetal taste with dry grass back notes and a sweet finish. An every-day drinking green tea, enjoyed by the tea-novice and aficionado alike

# Gen Mai Cha (organic) £4.20

A satisfying tea with an unusual flavour created by the contrast of grassy green Sencha tea with toasted rice kernels. First drunk by monks and Japanese people for sustenance, Genmaicha is now revered for its unique springy fresh, yet nutty taste. The rice is baked with the tea leaves, and some 'pop' giving it its nickname, 'popcorn tea'

## Jasmine Pearls £4.80

Our jasmine pearl tea is made from perfectly balanced spring green tea. Each pearl is hand-made by lightly rolling and wrapping fine, tender leaves and buds, drying and repeatedly scenting with fresh jasmine blossoms. When infused, they unravel to release a beautifully sweet aroma

#### White Tea

# White Peony £4.20

A succulent white tea composed of tightly curled buds with the top two tender young leaves. Picked and processed in spring, in Fujian province, China, the leaves undergo natural, ambient drying. This gives the tea its sweet muscatel aroma, soft melon notes, and smooth nutty flavour with a long lasting sweet aftertaste. White tea is high in antioxidants, and provides a gentle boost, any time of day

## Wulong Tea

### Honey Orchid (Mi Lan Dan Cong) £7.00

This dark and intense oolong is ripe with orchid fruit sweetness. The large leaves are baked to a deep reddish brown, producing a rich liquor, bursting with peach, lychee and honey flavours. Enjoy through multiple infusions to experience the changing character of the tea

## Iron Buddha (Tie Kuan Yin) £7.00

One of the best-known Chinese oolongs, with a delicate yet complex flavour. The spring green lace-edged leaves are crinkled into tight balls, which unravel to release an intense floral aroma. The taste is a subtle balance of fresh orchid flowers with a sweet, creamy smoothness. Enjoy through multiple infusions to experience the changing character of the tea

### Jasmine Fairies Performing Flower Tea £6.50

This Jasmine Fairies blooming flower tea unravels to flaunt an array dancing blossoms. Each one is hand-made with fresh flowers tenderly sewn to silver needle buds by skilled Chinese artisans, to create a unique display. The Mao Feng green tea has a mild taste, complemented by sweet floral aromas. They're naturally very low in caffeine, and high in antioxidants. Our flower teas are individually wrapped and sealed at source for maximum freshness, and each one can be steeped more than three times without tasting bitter

## Peppermint Super Grade £4.20

Striking and strong, this peppermint infusion has a fresh and brisk flavour with a hint of sweetness. Mints have long been used to cleanse the palate, aid digestion, clear the airways, and combat stress. By using the whole leaf and stem rather than just broken leaf fragments, this infusion draws out all the essential oils, for full depth of flavour, aroma, and health benefits. Soothing, refreshing, and de-stressing; perfect any time of day

## Chamomile Whole Flowers (organic) £4.20

Chamomile has been used for centuries for its liver cleansing and immune system boosting properties. Infusing whole flower heads gives a strong, clean flavour with a natural apple-sweet aftertaste. A soothing drink to enjoy any time of day, and perfect in the evening to calm and relax for a good night's sleep

## Rooibos Super Grade (organic) £4.20

## Whole Rose Buds (organic) £4.50

## Green Mulberry £4.50

A caffeine free, vitamin, mineral, and antioxidant rich infusion made from the leaves of the white mulberry plant. This is a superior quality green mulberry tea sent to us directly from the Ziamese sisters in north-east Thailand, who use only the most aromatic strain of green mulberry with the highest concentration of nutrients. Revered in traditional medicine, this truly is a wonder drink, said to be the scholars' choice in China. A malty brew with fresh grassy notes and a delicious sweet aftertaste

## Hibiscus (organic) £4.20
